

## **MEDIA CENTER ADDITION BRIDGETON HIGH SCHOOL BRIDGETON, NEW JERSEY**



### **Scale and Scope of Services**

As a result of significant growth in the community of Bridgeton, the school district implemented a major school facility expansion project. The Bridgeton High School Media Center had not been renovated in the 40 plus years that the High School has existed. A \$3.0 million Bond Referendum which included: The Instructional Media Center addition of 5,849 square feet and the renovation of 4,498 square feet. The Elevator Addition was 290 square feet for the first floor and 346 square feet for the second floor. Becica Associates provided Architectural and Engineering Services for the design of the alterations and renovations.

A subsequent related project was the replacement of the Bridgeton High School Auditorium heating, ventilation and air-conditioning system (HVAC). Three new roof-top HVAC units were installed. A new steel catwalk system was installed which provides a safer and more professional means of supplying lighting for stage production.

### **Program for the addition and renovation:**

- New computer classroom and instruction space
- New book stack areas
- Video projection and screen
- Instructional television connections
- Varied reading areas, from studios to casual
- Multi-use classroom/flexible learning space
- New elevator and lobby at the two story wing
- New accessible ramp leads to a new entrance to the elevator, which is built off of an existing hallway
