Program

To provide an auditorium to accommodate a prominent performing arts program and to modernize this existing band and practice rooms, the 25,000 square foot fully air-conditioned facility separate yet integrated into the existing campus-like setting of the High School. House seating totals 1,005 in a side entry format. Stage area includes 3,300 square feet with a full fly-loft space and when fully rigged will be capable of flying 30 bars. A recessed orchestra pit seats 50 musicians. Back stage areas include set production, dressing rooms, storage and a vocal music classroom. Production lighting and sound systems are state-of-the-art and were tailored to the District's needs and includes company switches for touring group usage.

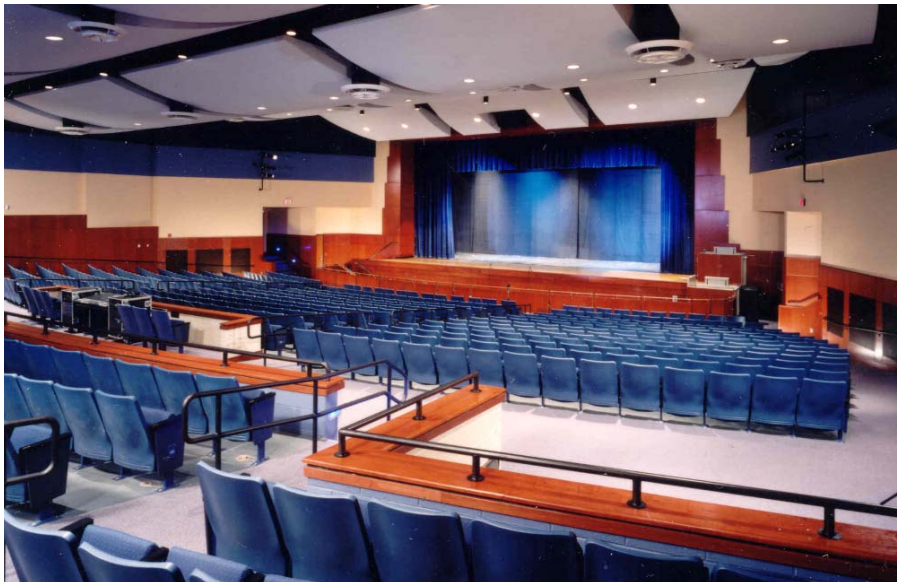
